IMPORTANT MESSAGE FROM THE RETURNING OFFICER

RE: BY-ELECTION PROCEDURES/TIMELINES, RETURNED MAIL, MEMBERS WITHOUT ADDRESSES & SPECIAL NOTIFICATIONS

April 3, 2020

The following is an outline of the chronological order of events scheduled to take place with respect to the mailout and return of ballots by all voting members.

DUE TO THE COVD-19 PANDEMIC, ALL DATES ARE TENTATIVE!

- Friday, July 2, 2020 Ballot packages to be mailed to all members.
- > Thursday, July 23, 2020 Recommended last "safe" day to have your vote in the mail.
- Monday, July 27, 2020 10 a.m. to 10 p.m. Walk in to deal with members regarding "undeliverable" mail. Location to be announced.
- **Tuesday, July 28, 2020** by 8 a.m. Closing date and time for receipt of returned ballots.
- Tuesday, July 28, 2020 CUPE Regional Office (80 Commerce Valley Drive East, Markham):

9 a.m. until completion - counting of all ballots.

- Wednesday, July 29, 2020 All official results and notifications to be completed.
- NEXT REGULARLY SCHEDULED GENERAL MEMBERSHIP MEETING The Returning Officer shall make available the results of the election to the membership at the next scheduled General Membership Meeting.

In order to be counted, your ballot must be received at the receiving Canada Post mailbox designated for receipt of Local 416 ballots <u>no later than 8 a.m. on July 28, 2020</u>. Any ballots received after this date and time will not be opened or counted.

Provisions will be made to have Local 416 members who are not listed in the database, or whose ballots were returned undeliverable, to exercise their right to vote as follows:
